CERTIFICATE I IN TRANSITION EDUCATION

The Certificate I in Transition Education is designed to help you develop the skills to find your best path in life.

This certificate supports you to choose a community option - employment, volunteering or further study.

The course will teach you a wide variety of skills including making a learning plan, using technology and travel activities.

The course will be 1 day per week for 6 hours a day in a classroom delivery. Pathways from this course could lead to further study in your chosen area or getting the job you want.

COURSE IN INITIAL ADULT LITERACY & NUMERACY

The Course in Initial Adult Literacy and Numeracy goes back to the beginning of reading, writing and mathematics.

It is the step before Certificate I and is designed for adult learners who want to build foundation skills such as reading and writing simple words, using simple numbers and symbols as well as recognising and using time.

This course would suit learners who want to gain everyday usable literacy and numeracy.

The course will run for 1 day per week for 6 hours a day in a classroom delivery.

TRANSITION TO WORK

Transition to Work is a pre-accredited course offered through the Christie Centre under the Learn Local banner. The course is for people wanting to build skills to get a job or for people who are already working and want to improve their skills.

It is a 13 week program designed to give learners essential skills in all areas of working, from resumes and interviews through to presentation and being on time.

The course is 1 day a week for 13 weeks and includes a blended delivery of classroom work and work experience at our social enterprises.
